Alan Rosling is Co-founder of ECube Climate Finance, an institution dedicated to lending to support climate mitigating investment in Indian business.

In 2010, Alan co-founded Kiran Energy, one of India's first independent solar power producers. Kiran was acquired by a strategic buyer in 2018.

He is also Senior Advisor to Navam Capital and Audere International, and serves as a Non-Executive Director on the boards of Vyome Therapeutics, Peotic Technologies and Insolight SA.

Alan was an Executive Director of Tata Sons Limited for five years from 2004 and was the Director responsible for internationalising the Tata Group. From 1998 to 2003 he was Chairman of the Jardine Matheson Group in India.

His earlier career included the Policy Unit at No.10 Downing Street; Strategy Director at United Distillers, CEO of a division of Courtaulds Textiles and S.G. Warburg.

Alan was educated at Cambridge University and the Harvard Business School. His first book, *Boom Country? The New Wave of Indian Enterprise*, was published by Hachette in 2017. He is a Charter Member of TiE and a director of TiE Hong Kong.
